**ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS
SATURDAY, 19th AUGUST 2017/SUNDAY 20th AUGUST 2017**

1. TROPHIES AND AWARDS:- M.S.A. 'E' PLATE will be awarded to the winner of the Festival Mini Max Class and may be used at all M.S.A. clubs until the end of 2018 or the date of the 2018 'E' Plate meeting whichever is earlier. Novices are not eligible for the 'E' Plate. The perpetual trophy remains the property of the ABkC and must be returned, in good condition, when requested or in any case one month before the 2018 Mini Max 'E' Plate Meeting.

2. ROTAX WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP QUALIFICATION

The ABkC 'O' Plate Championship will be the qualifying round of the Rotax World Championship to be held in Portugal. The winner of the ABkC 'O' Plate for Senior Rotax will be the competitor qualifying to represent Britain at the 2017 Rotax World Championship, providing that he/she holds the correct competition licence.

The winner will be provided with kart, engine, tyres, fuel, oil etc. The winner will be required to pay air fares and hotel accommodation for himself/herself and provide an pay all expenses of a mechanic. The winner must also pay for all damages to the equipment supplied.

The winner of the Rotax Festival Junior Max Championship will be the competitor qualifying to represent Britain at the 2017 Junior Max World Championship. All terms and conditions for the Junior Rotax Qualification are the same as those listed for the Senior Max final.

3. TYRES

The control tyres for the Senior Max 'O' Plate Championship must be purchased from the CLAY KART SHOP at a price of £122.34 + V.A.T. (£146.80). The tyres must be paid for at the time of entry and a receipt will be sent to you. A tyre draw will take place on Saturday, 19th August 2017 at 5.30p.m. in the circuit workshop (blue building). The tyre draw will be supervised by a member of the scrutineering team. After drawing for your tyres you must fit to your rims within parc ferme and leave in parc ferme until your mandatory practice on Sunday morning. After mandatory practice, qualifying, heat and pre-final, the wheels/tyres must be removed from your kart and deposited in parc ferme.

4. Non compliance with these regulations will be dealt with by the Clerk of the Course and could lead to exclusion from the meeting.
